Hanna Matys was appointed Deputy Chair of the State Property Fund of Ukraine on August 24, 2026. Prior to this appointment, she served as Director of the Legal Department at the State Property Fund of Ukraine.

Hanna Matys is an expert in law, public administration, state property management, and corporate governance, with over 25 years of professional experience.

In 1999, she graduated from Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv with a degree in Law, earning a Master of Laws degree. In 2010, she was awarded the honorary title of Honored Lawyer of Ukraine.

She began her career at the State Property Fund of Ukraine, advancing from leading specialist to leadership roles in the Fund's Regional Office for the City of Kyiv. She later headed the Legal Support Department and the Legal Department of the Fund.
